The show enjoyed its fruitful run in Beverly Hills, then was moved to Broadway. While in NYC, Josh's industry network expanded, his intensive labors paid off, and he was able to enjoy the culmination of all his hard work molding into a successful start of a fulfilling professional career.



A confirmation letter/invoice will be emailed approximately two weeks following your reservation to the email Please provided. review vour reservation carefully. If there are any notify changes, please IPAC immediately. If you do not receive your confirmation, or your reservation is incorrect, please contact us as soon as possible. Reservations are not fully complete until the Janesville Performing Arts Center receives full payment. You will receive final confirmation approximately 7 days prior to the performances. The confirmation will include information regarding your visit as well as a reminder of payment due.

WEATHER RELATED CANCELLATIONS

The Janesville Performing Arts Center will decide to cancel, delay or post-pone a show due to weather by 8:00am on the day of the performance. We will make every effort to alert schools of such changes. School time performances are only cancelled if the performers cannot make it due to weather. Weather-related cancellations issued by the Janesville Performing Arts Center will offer an alternative performance date or a full refund. If a school is unable to attend a performance due to weather, a credit will be issued to the school so they may attend a future performance.

PARKING & DIRECTIONS

The Janesville Performing Arts Center is located in Janesville, WI in close proximity to Interstate 39/90. The center is located off of exit 175A (Racine Street) at the intersection of Racine and Main. Free on-site parking is located between the center and the Hedberg Public Library. Buses can drop students off at the front door and then park in the parking lot or on the street in front of the building.

ARRIVAL & DISMISSAL

Arrival: Please arrive no later than 15 minutes before show time.

Dismissal: Groups will be dismissed by school after the performance. Please remain seated until your school is called.

PAYMENT

Although payment is not due when the reservation is placed, please adhere to the following:

- A minimum of 60 days notice is required in order to completely cancel your reservation. If а cancellation is requested after this deadline. the school will still be responsible for payment of the original reservation. Reservations placed after the cancellation date are considered final sales.
- Payment must be received two weeks prior to the performance.
- If additional seats are needed, please contact the Janesville Performing Arts Center for an adjustment.
- No cash or checks from individuals students or parents, please. Payment should be made in a single payment payable to the "Janesville Performing Arts Center."
